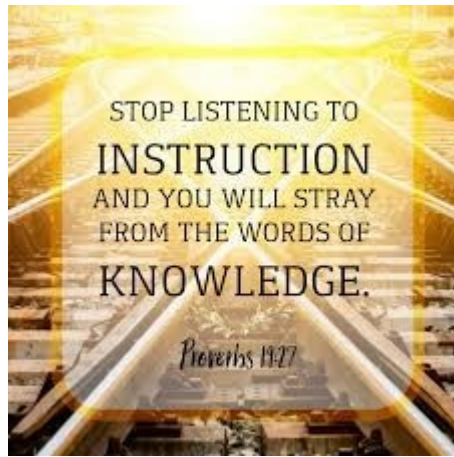




**Sunday,
